Application for renewal of CRICOS registration

I refer to your organisation's application to renew its registration under the <u>Education Services</u> for Overseas Students Act 2000 (ESOS Act).

In accordance with the provisions of section 10E of the ESOS Act, the National Vocational Education and Training Regulator (the Regulator) has approved your organisation's application to renew its registration on the *Commonwealth Register of Institutions and Courses for Overseas Students* (CRICOS). A copy of the final Quality Self-Assurance Review Summary Report is attached for your reference.

The Regulator is the person appointed to make decisions under the <u>National Vocational</u> <u>Education and Training Regulator Act 2011</u> (NVR Act) and works as a part of the Australian Skills Quality Authority (ASQA). ASQA's work supports the Regulator in their decision-making.

Please note that under section 8 of the ESOS Act it is an offence to provide or make an offer to an overseas student to provide a course at a location unless you are registered to provide that particular course at that particular location.

Maximum Number of Students

The Regulator has considered the capacity of your organisation in terms of its premises, approved arrangements with other providers, facilities, resources, equipment, materials and the ratio of staff to student numbers.

The maximum capacity approved by the Regulator remains as 1705 overseas students.

Conditions on Registration

There are no conditions imposed on your organisation's registration.

Period of Registration

Your organisation has been granted registration for a period of 7 years which commences on 1 July 2022 and is due to expire on 30 June 2029. You will note this expiry date coincides with your organisation's registration as a registered training organisation under the *National Vocational Education and Training Regulator Act 2011*.

Your organisation can apply to the ASQA to renew or withdraw its registration, and timeframes and obligations apply to each process. There are also obligations on an organisation that effectively ceases to operate, even though they remain registered as a registered provider. Further information about obligations in these circumstances is available from the ASQA website at www.asqa.gov.au.

Changes to CRICOS Registration

Your organisation must apply to ASQA if it wishes to change its courses registered under the ESOS Act. Information on the process to make changes to your organisation's registration under the ESOS Act is available from the ASQA website at <u>www.asqa.gov.au</u>.

Please note that an application to change your RTO's scope of registration is **not** also an application to vary your CRICOS registration. An application to change your CRICOS registration must be submitted separately.

Maintaining Compliance

During its period of registration your organisation must comply with the:

- <u>Education Services for Overseas Students Act 2000</u>
- Education Services for Overseas Students Regulations 2019
- <u>National Code of Practice for Providers of Education and Training to Overseas Students</u> 2018 (National Code 2018).

During the period of its registration, our organisation must also comply with the VET Quality Framework (as defined in the <u>National Vocational Education and Training Regulator Act 2011</u>) in respect of VET courses and the <u>ELICOS Standards 2018</u> in respect of ELICOS courses.
