Subject Overview	Extending on concepts learned in planning and hosting festivals, this subject provides students with the knowledge and skills required to address the logistical challenges associated with the conduct of both indoor and outdoor festivals. The effective design of spaces (servicescape) and experiences (experiencescape) along with broader elements including the movement of people, infrastructure, and facilities to, from and around festival sites is crucial in securing a sustainable, safe, and successful event. By exploring case studies, the logistical issues linked with elements such as sound, entry and exit points, can be discussed, and analysed by students. The development of necessary documentation and communication of operational requirements to a range of internal and external stakeholders, will assist student to consolidate and synthesise knowledge. To utterly understand logistics is to be able to "predict the unanticipated" and be able to quickly find the most favourable solution and integrate it into the plan so that the festival can go off without a hitch.
