What will I study?

All students must study full time by selecting a minimum of three and no more than four subjects (from year one and two degree studies) to complete within one semester. This is a total of 24 credit points where each subject is worth six credit points (this is equivalent to 3 – 4 credit points in the USA and Japan).

To apply you must have:
